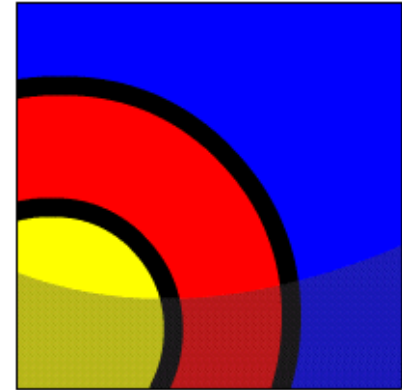


Mock Interview

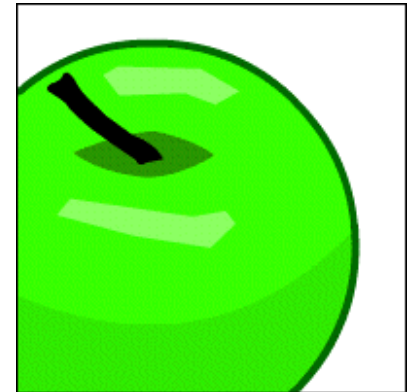
Interviewing is an art.

One of the questions can be something personal, and the others should focus on business.

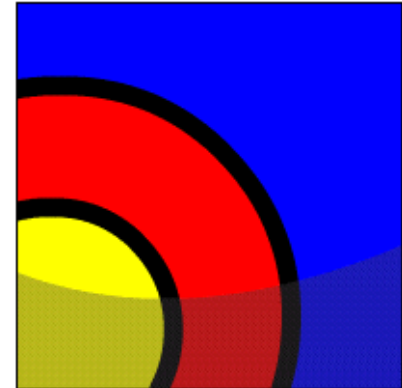




Summary
